When Wilbert Minja talks, people listen. He lives in a village in Tanzania, 1,700 meters up the south slope of Mount Kilimanjaro, and his neighbors call him Mzee — Swahili for “wise old man.” He talks about how worried he is. The weather is all wrong, he says. “Rain falls when it should not, and does not come when it should.” He recalls how new people used to come to live on the mountainside, attracted by its rich soil and abundant fresh water.
